The Network: Advocating Against Domestic Violence established an Emergency Crisis Fund for survivors of Domestic Violence to address critical gaps in the safety net for survivors. The Fund prioritizes support for survivors where no other funding is applicable. Examples of supports include, but are not limited to: one month's rental assistance, educational and social supports for e-learning for clients in shelter or community emergency housing, diapers, support for incarcerated survivors, emergency bills, or transportation. Other requests will be considered. Please allow 2-3 weeks for application process to be completed, you will be notified via email when funds are distributed. Due to the demand of emergency funding, we can only provide funding once per applicant.
